Channel your passion and creative visual communication talents into a rewarding career as a graphic designer or illustrator. Create beautiful illustrations or graphic design for print publications and packaging, branding and visual identity campaigns, and for digital spaces including the web, apps, and motion graphics.



Job opportunities

Graphic designers use colour, typography, symbols, imagery, and layout, to design assets for digital or print publication. They produce advertisements, logos, branding, icons and other visuals to illustrate and communicate messages to their intended audiences.

You could work in-house for a company or organisation, for an agency studio, or as a self-employed freelance designer. Jobs include finished artists, graphic designer, web and app designers, art director, illustrator, interaction designer, or motion graphics.

Fees for your course


