As a beauty professional you will use a variety of skills to perform a broad range of beauty therapy treatments and services, which may include facial treatments, body massage and treatments, hair removal, lash and brow treatments, nail and make-up services and include consultation with clients to provide beauty advice, recommend beauty treatments and services, and retail skincare and cosmetic products. In addition an advance diploma qualified therapist can provide laser and IPL laser hair reduction services.



Job opportunities¹

Employment for Beauty Therapists is projected to grow by 4,600 (12.2%) between 2021 and 2026.

Employment across the sector is forecast to grow by more than 29,160 jobs or 44.6% by 2026.

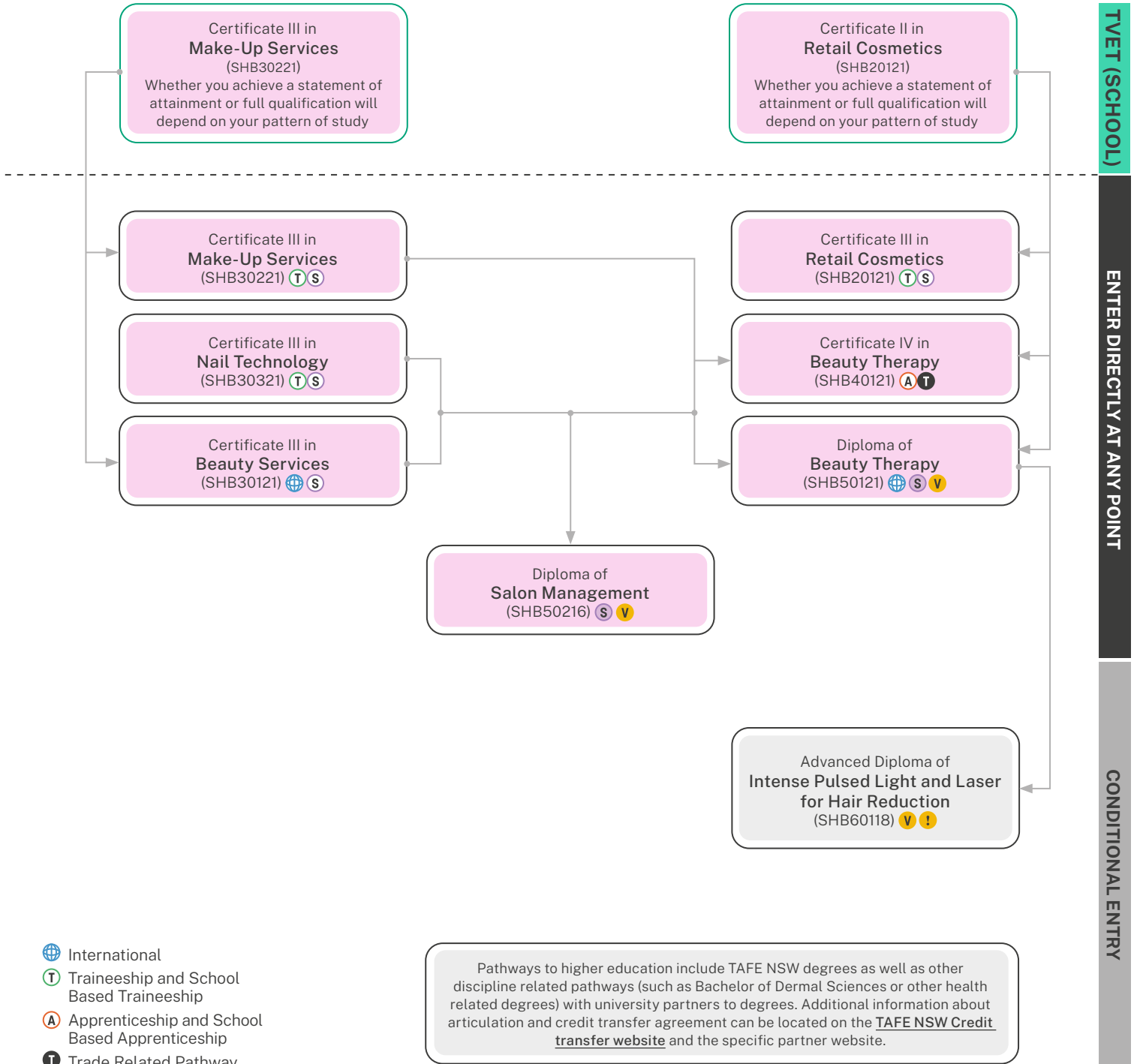
Fees for your course
