### Fees for your course

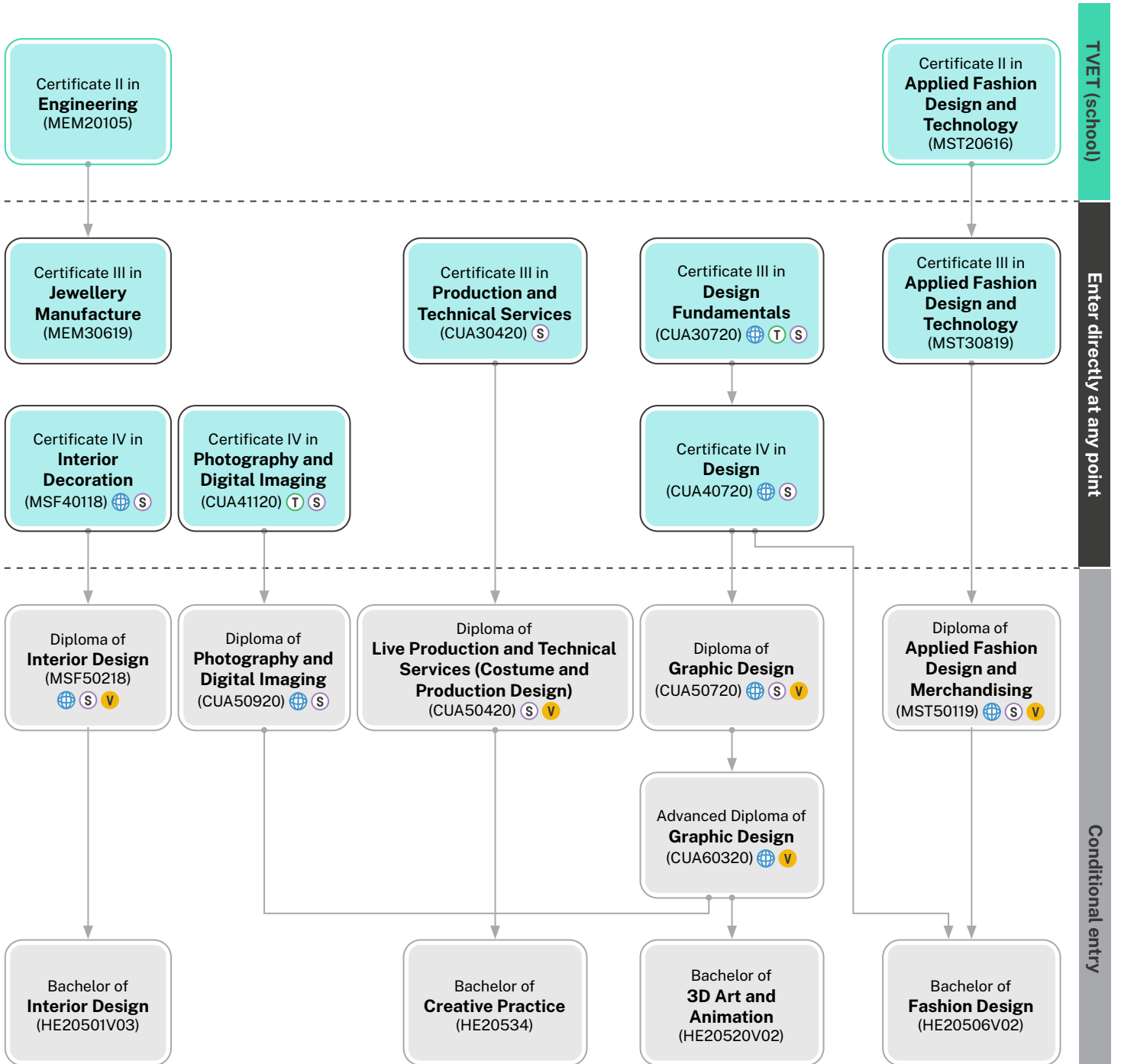
