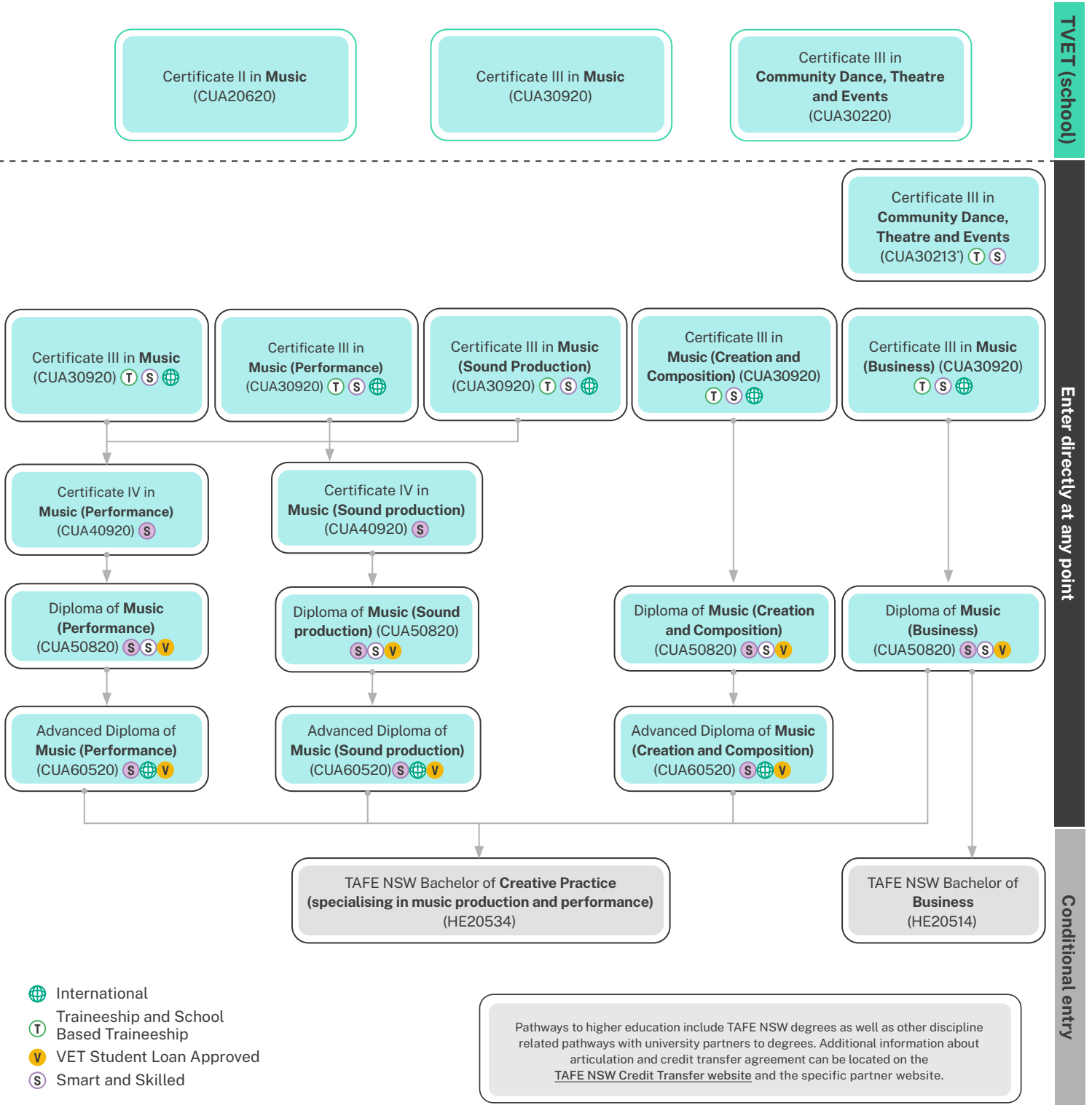
Fees for your course
