You'll learn the necessary safety skills, as well as:

- ways to identify and control weeds and pests
- attending field trips to commercial bushfoods properties
- practical insights into the industry and issues

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

This is a customised course for Aboriginal people. Talk to us about your eligibility to receive subsidised travel, accommodation and study. Many of our students who live or work throughout NSW are eligible for subsidised training places under 'Smart and Skilled' and a full fee exemption.

COMPETENCIES

You must be able to demonstrate vocational competency in the Production Horticultural area. Vocational competency is defined as broad industry knowledge and experience, and may include, but is not limited to, holding a relevant unit of competency or qualification.

You must have access to, or be working in;

- a horticultural enterprise
- community or school vegetable garden, or
- be self-employed in horticulture
