

Accessing TAFE NSW’s Digital Services – How to Install ADOBE Creative Cloud




Purpose


This Quick Reference Guide sets out the steps that TAFE NSW students can take to install the ADOBE Creative Cloud Suite.

Background


Depending on their approved course of study, Students may be able to use Adobe Creative Cloud to access a collection of software applications used for graphic design, video editing, web development, photography etc.

Accessing the Creative Cloud Application

<p>In your preferred browser, navigate to https://creativecloud.adobe.com</p> <p>The Creative Cloud Home Page will display</p> <p>Click Sign In in the top right corner of the screen to access the login portal</p>	
<p>The Sign In page will display</p> <p>Enter your @studytafensw.edu.au email address in the Email address field. For example firstname.lastname123@studytafensw.edu.au then press Continue</p>	
<p>If prompted select company or school account</p>

<p>You will be redirected to the TAFE NSW login portal. If so, log in with your student login details (for example - firstname.lastname123) then press Log In.</p> <p>Once authenticated, you will be able to access and use the Adobe Creative Cloud applications that are associated with your approved course of study.</p>	

Downloading the Creative Cloud Applications

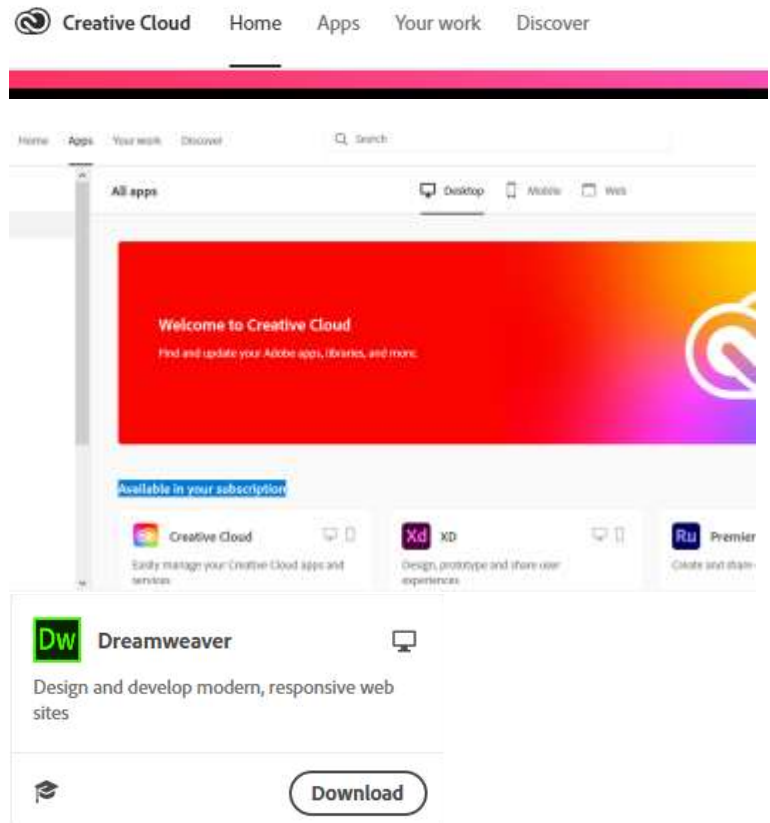

<p>From your preferred Web Browser navigate to https://creativecloud.adobe.com</p>	


The Creative Cloud Home Page will display

Select Apps.

Locate the desired app(s) **from the “Available in your subscription”** section and click their corresponding Download link, then follow the prompts to install the software. N.B. Each application downloads the Creative Cloud Desktop App if it isn’t installed on your computer already.

For example – if Dreamweaver is required click on the Download button
