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# GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN LEADERSHIP

## Step up to the next level and become a leader in your field.

The Graduate Certificate in Leadership is a post graduate course that will give you the skills to become a leader or manager in your area of expertise. You will learn how to be a leader who is committed to the delivery of first class innovative services, who will contribute to future economic and social development, and who has the skills to contribute to your organisation's ongoing sustainability.

The course requires the completion of four subjects in which you will learn the importance of collaborative and outcomes oriented leadership, how to develop collaborative partnerships as well as how to develop management strategies to develop business alliances both in domestic and international settings.

The Graduate Certificate in Leadership encourages you to use case studies from your own industry, ensuring your learning is relevant to your experiences and goals.

## HOW TO COMPLETE THE COURSE

The Graduate Certificate in Leadership requires you to complete 4 subjects and a total of 40 credit points.

## GET RECOGNITION FOR PREVIOUS STUDY AND EXPERIENCE

If you've completed studies at this level in a related field, or if you have extensive and current industry or workplace experience, you may be eligible for exemption from some subjects. All applications for exemption must be made to the course coordinator and must include supporting documentation. You should attend classes until you are formally advised that your exemption has been granted.

## COURSE STRUCTURE

All students must complete a total of four subjects: 3 compulsory subjects plus one elective. The availability of electives will be at the discretion of the campus. Each subject is worth 10 credit points (CP).

### Compulsory subjects

<b>LELSP101A</b>	Leadership theory and practice (10CP)
<b>LELSP102A</b>	Leading in emergent and changing environments (10CP)
<b>LELSP103A</b>	Developing and leading people (10CP)

### Electives - select one

<b>LELSP104A</b>	Leadership in the context of emerging technologies (10CP)
<b>LEORG101A</b>	Organisational design and culture (10CP)
<b>LELSG101A</b>	Strategic business sustainability (10CP)

## STUDY MODE AND DURATION

### Graduate Certificate

- One semester full time or part time equivalent

Each subject requires 3 hours of weekly, face-to-face class attendance.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must hold one of the following to be eligible for admission:

- a bachelor degree; or
- an diploma or higher level vocational (VET) qualification PLUS two years relevant workplace experience; or
- a minimum of two years workplace experience PLUS evidence of the potential to undertake academic learning at this level.

## TUITION FEES

### Domestic students:

- \$1,565 per 10 credit point subject
- \$6,260 indicative full graduate certificate course fee

### International students:

This course is not open to enrolment by students on an international student visa.
