UNDERGRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN EARLY CHILDHOOD SPECIAL NEEDS

Course Code: HE20540

The Undergraduate Certificate in Early Childhood Special Needs is a short course for people who work with children younger than five years of age, who have special needs.

The course requires the completion of four subjects covering exceptional children, gifted education, working with families and communities and inclusive practices in early childhood.

HOW TO COMPLETE THE COURSE

The Undergraduate Certificate in Early Childhood Special Needs requires you to complete four subjects and a total of 40 credit points.

COURSE STRUCTURE

All students must complete the following four subjects:

- Exceptional Children: Early Intervention
- Working with Families and Community Partnerships
- Inclusive Practice and Principles in Early Childhood
- Gifted Education

RECOGNITION OF PREVIOUS STUDY AND EXPERIENCE

If you have completed studies at this level in a related field, or if you have extensive and current industry or workplace experience, you may be eligible for exemption from some subjects. All applications for exemption must be made to the course coordinator and must include supporting documentation. You should attend classes until you are formally advised that your exemption has been granted.

PATHWAYS TO FURTHER STUDY

Students who complete the Undergraduate Certificate in Early Childhood Special Needs and choose to continue their studies in the Bachelor of Early Childhood Education and Care (Birth-5), will receive credit for the four completed subjects.

STUDY MODE AND DURATION

This course is delivered over one semester full time, or over a part time equivalent.

COURSE DELIVERY LOCATION

Students can study this course at TAFE NSW Glendale.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for admission into the Undergraduate Certificate in Early Childhood Special Needs, you must have completed a diploma or higher qualification in early childhood education and care.

TUITION FEES

Domestic students:

In 2021 domestic students will pay a tuition fee of \$1,925 for the full subsidised course fee.

Domestic students - full fees:

\$1,180 per 10 credit point subject.
\$4,720 indicative full course fee.

International students:

This course is not open to enrolment by students on an international student visa.
