

Higher Education assessment policy

1. Introduction

Assessment in TAFE NSW Higher Education courses is the process of collecting evidence and making judgements on whether a student has fulfilled subject learning outcomes, aims and objectives.

2. Purpose

This policy governs the processes by which learning is assessed and the integrity of assessment practices across all aspects of a TAFE NSW Higher Education course is assured.

3. Scope

This policy applies to all TAFE NSW Higher Education courses, subjects, students and academic staff.

4. Policy

Assessment conducted by TAFE NSW Higher Education will be:

- designed to enable students to demonstrate the achievement of subject learning outcomes and to facilitate intellectual development;
- consistent with the maintenance of academic standards and academic rigour;
- valid, reliable, consistent and equitable, and will allow for suitable adjustment for students with disabilities;
- moderated, monitored and reviewed to improve quality and address anomalies.

5. Responsibilities

Position	Responsibility
Higher Education Academic Council	The Higher Education Academic Council is the approver of this policy.
Associate Director Higher Education Standards	The Associate Director Higher Education Standards is the owner of this policy.
Dean of Higher Education	The Dean of Higher Education has overall responsibility for the effective administration and implementation of this policy.
Course Coordinators	Course Coordinators have local responsibility for the effective administration and implementation of this policy.
