Fees for your course



[^] Depending on the location and community language, there may be some eligibility requirements for these courses, where you might need to identify as an Aboriginal person or have the approval of the local Aboriginal community if you are a non-Aboriginal person. You will therefore need to participate in an interview with one of our teaching staff to make sure this is the appropriate course and level for you.
