HOW YOU CAN GROW YOUR CAREER

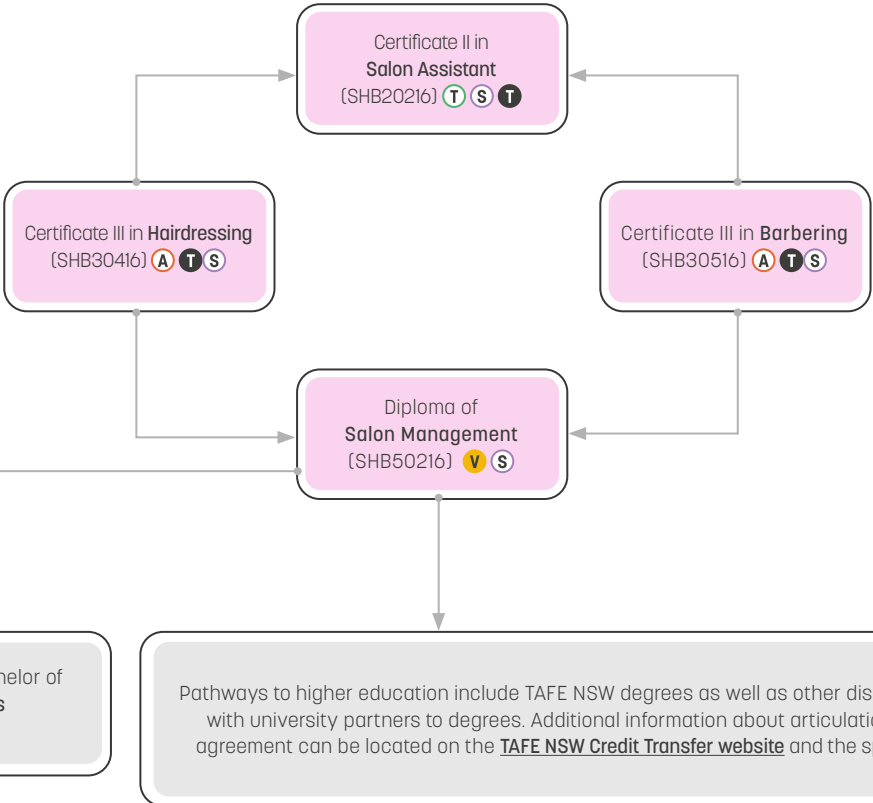
