The eastern seaboard, including Sydney Harbour, Botany Bay, Newcastle, Port Kembla, the NSW North Coast, and the Gold Coast, are all thriving hubs for maritime operations, with employment expected to almost double in the next eight years. The Australian Maritime Safety Authority requires all maritime personnel to maintain competency and also conducts regular inspections of commercial and passenger vessels regarding seaworthiness, safety and International Maritime Organisation regulations compliance.


