#### **FEES FOR YOUR COURSE**



<sup>^</sup> To be eligible for this course, you must identify as an Aboriginal person or have the approval of the local Aboriginal community if you are a non-Aboriginal person. You will also need to participate in a phone interview with one of our teaching staff to make sure this is the appropriate course level for you.
