Course Description

Are you a hands-on problem solver? Do you have the drive to learn how things work? Does tomorrow's innovation and racing technology get you revved up? If so, then this Light Vehicle Automotive Program may be for you!

The Automotive industry is broad and encompasses a variety of activities and businesses. These activities include repair and service of vehicles; retailing of vehicles; parts and tools; repair, maintenance, repair and service of bicycles, outdoor power equipment, marine vessels and motorcycles; and some non-car manufacturing. As at May 2018, the industry employs over 356,000 Australians.

In preparation for employment, you will have access to job seeking support and training and be introduced to employers and mentors. **You will also be exposed to a week of work experience at Peter Warren Automotive** with the potential to obtain a Light Vehicle Automotive Apprenticeship.
