Two years, part time.

COURSE DELIVERY LOCATIONS

This course is fully online

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- This course requires you to have a vocational background and current industry experience and/ or a vocational qualification in the area you intend to teach in after graduating from the Diploma of Adult Education.

TUITION FEES

Domestic students:

\$1,150 per 10 credit point subject
\$9,200 indicative full Diploma course fee.

International students:

This course is not open to enrolment by students on an international student visa.

Do you have an area of expertise which you could teach to others? Then the Diploma of Adult Education could be for you.

The course is a two year part-time qualification that gives you the practical skills you need to design and deliver top quality training programs in your area of expertise.

You will learn to design learning and assessment programs that engage learners so they benefit from your knowledge and expertise. You will learn to develop your skills to organise, implement and evaluate the training and assessment you deliver, and learn how to deliver your training using digital technology.

After completing the Diploma of Adult Education, you will be qualified to work as a trainer or assessor in your chosen discipline, in a range of professional contexts including at TAFE NSW, private RTOs, professional development and in-house training.

COMPLETING THE COURSE

To complete the Diploma of Adult Education, students must complete 8 subjects, and achieve 80 credit points. Each subject is worth 10 credit points.

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COURSE STRUCTURE

The structure below is the typical study pattern for a full-time student. Study pattern is determined by the location. All subjects are worth 10 credit points (CP). 80 credit points are required to complete this course.
