WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS?

NSW HSC (Higher School Certificate) or equivalent OR Recognised Tertiary Preparation Certificate OR Certificate IV level or higher vocational qualification OR completion of at least one year full-time study or equivalent in a degree course at a higher education institution

TUITION FEES

Domestic students:

\$1,150 per 10 credit point subject
\$9,200 indicative full Diploma course fee.

International students:

This course is not open to enrolment by students on an international student visa.

Students complete eight subjects which cover the key areas of knowledge essential for effective sustainability practitioners. The course uses a project-based learning approach which engages students with sustainability scenarios relevant to their work environment.

The Diploma of Sustainable Practice also helps graduates gain or maintain professional certification with the International Society of Sustainability Professionals (ISSP).

After completing the course, you will have built the skills needed to work in sustainability roles in government, business and community sectors.

HOW DO I COMPLETE THE COURSE?

The Diploma of Sustainable Practice requires you to complete 8 subjects and a total of 80 credit points.
