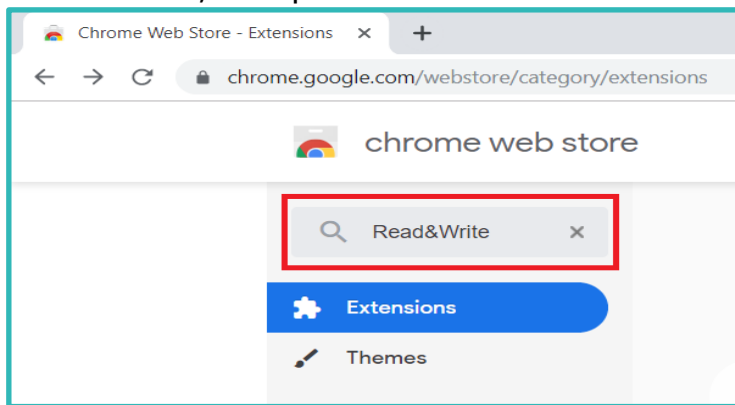


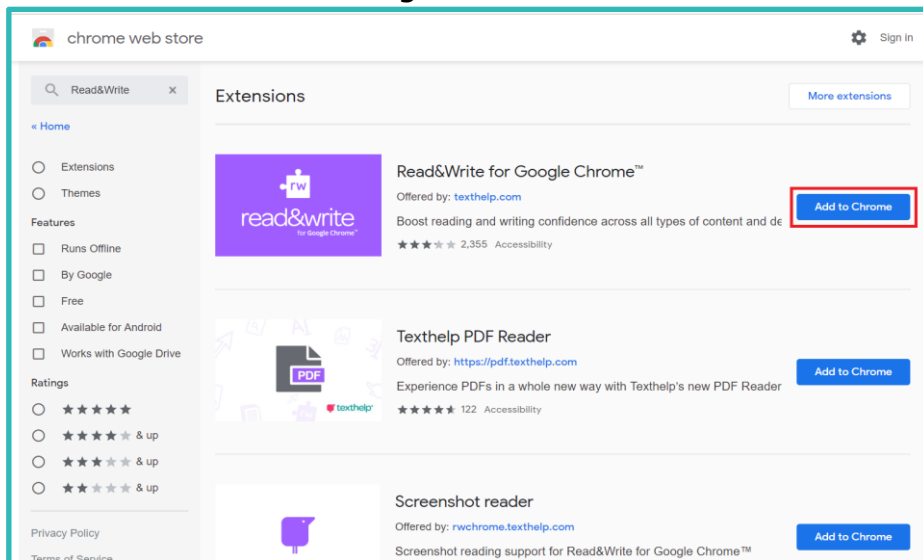
Installing Read&Write for Google Chrome

Let's Get Started

1. Click the link below to access the Google Chrome extension web store : <https://chrome.google.com/webstore/category/extensions>
2. In the search field on the top left-hand side of the web page, type Read&Write, and press Enter



3. Look for the Read&Write for Google Chrome extension and click on Add to Chrome button on the right-hand side.



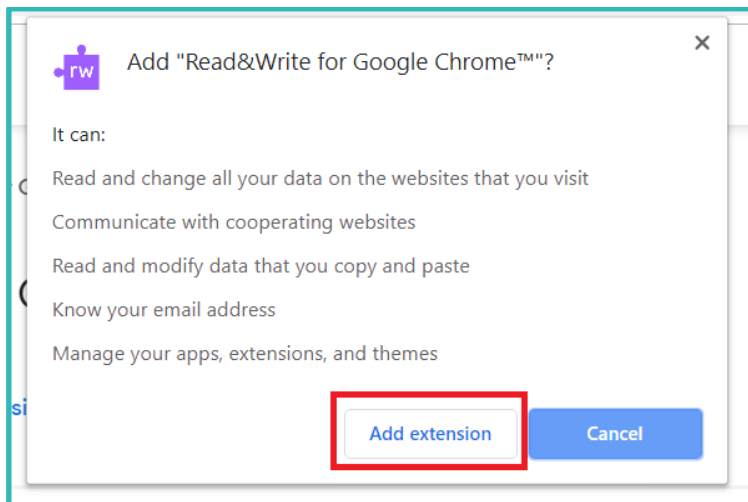
Installation Process

1. To add Read&Write for Google Chrome, click on Add extension

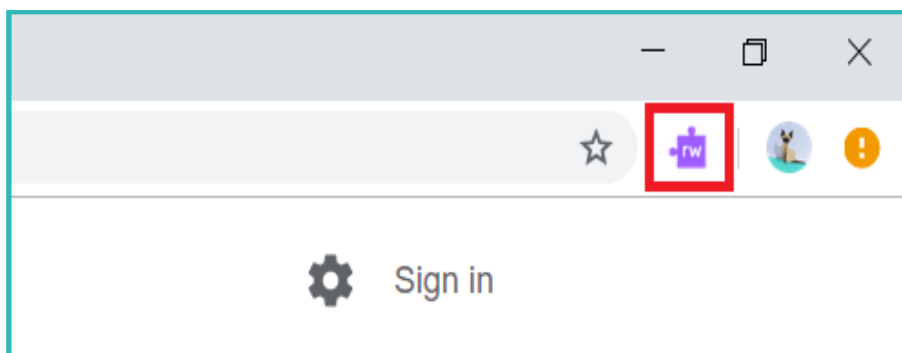
2. This will begin installing the extension onto your Google Chrome browser.

Once complete, it will add the Read&Write icon  to your extensions list at the top right corner of your browser, as shown below.

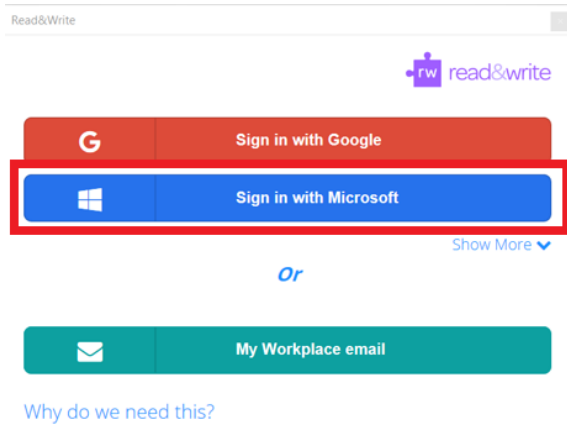
Signing in

When running Read&Write for the first time, you will be required to sign in to access Premium features. To sign in to Read&Write: -

1. Click the icon on the Read&Write icon at the top right corner of your browser



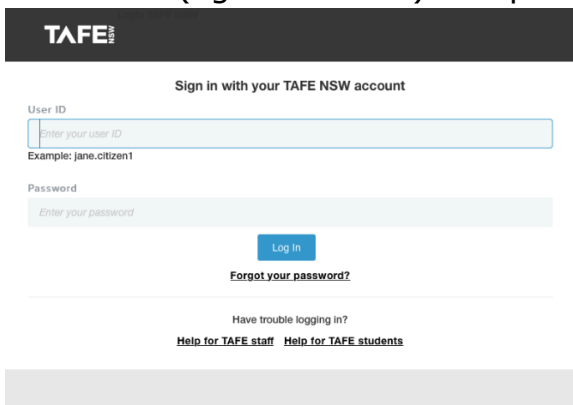
2. Select the sign in with Microsoft option



3. Sign in with your TAFENSW email account then click Next

4. You will be redirected to the TAFENSW Sign In page. Enter your TAFENSW username (eg user.name) and password to Log in.
