



# BE SUPPORTED BY THE NSW ABORIGINAL HOUSING OFFICE ACCOMMODATION GRANT.

RECEIVE UP TO \$10,000 TO ASSIST WITH ACCOMMODATION COSTS.

## ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this grant, students must:

- be Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander
- provide proof of age (16 years and older)
- be enrolled in a full time course, on-campus diploma, advanced diploma, degree course, or in a recognised university bridging pathways course (such as IPROWD)
- provide evidence that they are a social housing tenant or experiencing housing stress (housing stress is defined as an individual expending more than 40% of weekly income on housing)
- provide evidence of independent living (forms of evidence below)
- provide proof of income
- provide a 'Statement of Claim' (see application form for further details)

## GRANT INFORMATION AND CONSTRAINTS

The grants are capped at up to \$10,000 per student, and are for accommodation related expenses only. The full grant will be administered by the tertiary institution as a stipend payment into the student's nominated bank account.

The grants are exclusively for Aboriginal students who are enrolled in a full time studies, or are in an accredited university bridging pathways program.

## STUDENT OBLIGATIONS

Students will be required to provide evidence on their intended independent living arrangement. Students intending on leaving or deferring will need to provide this information to [aboriginalscholarships@tafensw.edu.au](mailto:aboriginalscholarships@tafensw.edu.au). Student may be required to provide receipts to acquit the grant funds (upon request only) and students are required to participate in a pre and post survey.
