- you are enrolled as a full time student, or as an apprentice or trainee, in a course of study at TAFE NSW Wagga Wagga or TAFE NSW Primary Industries Centre, commencing in 2021, and
- you:
 - have served in the Australian Defence Force, or
 - are a Junior Legatee and are attached to a Legacy Club, or
 - are a partner of a serving member of the Australian Defence Force, or
 - are a dependant or direct descendant of a currently serving, or retired member of the Australian Defence Force.

SCHOLARSHIP VALUE

The scholarship is worth \$2,000, and will be presented to the successful applicant at a ceremony held at TAFE NSW Wagga Wagga.

APPLICATIONS

You must provide the following information with your application:

- the discharge certificate, OR name, service number, rank, and unit of the serving or retired member of the Australian Defence Force
- references, and the names and contact details of two referees
- you may also include any other information or documentation which you believe will support your application.

INTERVIEWS

After consideration, a shortlist of applicants will be called to attend an interview, to be held at TAFE NSW Wagga Wagga on a date to be advised. Final selection will be made by the selection committee on the basis of the application, interview, and referee's reports.
