The Legacy Club of Wagga Wagga is offering a scholarship for a course of study at TAFE NSW Wagga Wagga or the TAFE NSW Primary Industries Centre. The scholarship will provide financial assistance to enable the selected student to further their education and career.

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for this scholarship, applicants must:

be enrolled as a full time student, or as an apprentice or trainee, in a course of study at TAFE NSW Wagga Wagga or TAFE NSW Primary Industries Centre, commencing in 2024, and

- have served in the Australian Defence Force, or
- be a Junior Legatee and are attached to a Legacy Club, or
- be a partner of a serving member of the Australian Defence Force, or
- be a dependant or direct descendant of a currently serving, or retired member of the Australian Defence Force.



Important information

You must provide the following information with your application:

- the discharge certificate, OR name, service number, rank, and unit of the serving or retired member of the Australian Defence Force
- references, and the names and contact details of two referees
- you may also include any other information or documentation which you believe will support your application.

After consideration, a shortlist of applicants will be called to attend an interview, to be held at TAFE NSW Wagga Wagga on a date to be advised. Final selection will be made by the selection committee on the basis of the application, interview, and referee's reports.

Terms and Conditions

1.0 Establishment and purpose

- 1.1 The Legacy Club of Wagga Wagga Scholarship was established to provide support to committed students who are in need of financial assistance or encouragement to complete their studies.
- 1.2 The scholarship is funded, managed and administrated by the Legacy Club of Wagga Wagga.
- 1.3 A panel will be established to determine successful scholarship applicants.

2.0 Definitions

- 2.1 **"Applicant"** means an individual who applies for the Legacy Club of Wagga Wagga Scholarship by completing and submitting a scholarship application form in accordance with the application process.
- 2.2 **"Application process"** means the process set out in clause 3.0 of these terms and conditions as amended or varied by TAFE NSW from time to time in its sole discretion.
- 2.3 **"Eligible applicant"** means an applicant who meets the criteria for eligibility for the award of a Legacy Club of Wagga Wagga Scholarship as set out in clause 4.0 of the terms and conditions.
- 2.4 **"Panel"** means a panel to assess applicants on their scholarship application
- 2.5 **"Legacy Club of Wagga Wagga Scholarship"** means a financial grant up to a maximum value of \$2000 awarded by Legacy Club of Wagga Wagga in accordance with these terms and conditions.
- 2.6 **"Scholarship application"** means an application for a Legacy Club of Wagga Wagga Scholarship made by an applicant in accordance with these terms and conditions.
- 2.7 **"Scholarship application form"** means the form which must be completed by an applicant and which is available from tafensw.edu.au/scholarships
- 2.8 **"Scholarship offer and acceptance form"** means the form which must be completed by the successful applicant and is to be issued by TAFE NSW.
- 2.9 **"Scholarship recipient"** means the successful applicant who accepts the Legacy Club of Wagga Wagga Scholarship by completing and returning the scholarship offer and acceptance form in accordance with the process set out in clause 6.0 of these terms and conditions.
- 2.10 **"Student"** means a currently enrolled student of TAFE NSW
- 2.11 **"Successful applicant"** means an eligible applicant who is offered the Legacy Club of Wagga Wagga Scholarship by TAFE NSW in accordance with the process set out in clause 5.0 of these terms and conditions.

3.0 Application process

- 3.1 An applicant must complete a scholarship application form and submit it to TAFE NSW, by email, by the close off date.
- 3.2 The applicant must acknowledge and accept the scholarship terms and conditions by signing and dating their application form prior to submitting the scholarship application form in the manner set out in clause 3.1
- 3.3 At the discretion of TAFE NSW and the Legacy Club of Wagga Wagga the application dates can be extended.

4.0 Eligibility

- 4.1 The Legacy Club of Wagga Wagga Scholarship may be awarded to an eligible applicant who has completed and lodged an application form and who, as determined by the panel as eligible (in its discretion), satisfies all of the following criteria:
 - 4.1.1 Applicants must be enrolled as a full time student, or as an apprentice or trainee, in a course of study at TAFE NSW Wagga Wagga or TAFE NSW Primary Industries Centre, commencing in 2024.
 - 4.1.2 Applicants must:
 - have served in the Australian Defence Force, or
 - be a Junior Legatee and are attached to a Legacy Club, or
 - be a partner of a serving member of the Australian Defence Force, or
 - be a dependant or direct descendant of a currently serving, or retired member of the Australian Defence Force.
- 4.2 Incomplete scholarship application form will not be considered by the panel.
- 4.3 TAFE NSW is under no obligation to attempt to contact any applicant who incorrectly completes and/or submits an application form and will, at his or her discretion, contact an applicant on not more than two (2) occasions in an effort to obtain information which is missing, or has not been completed correctly. Should all required information not be provided, the scholarship application form will be withdrawn and notice sent to the applicant.

5.0 Offer of scholarship

- 5.1 The panel will determine the Legacy Club of Wagga Wagga Scholarship recipients in its sole discretion.
- 5.2 The successful applicant will be notified by telephone and email, and will be sent a scholarship offer and acceptance form to complete.
- 5.3 If unsuccessful, an applicant will be notified in writing of that outcome.

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6.0 Acceptance of scholarship

- 6.1 A scholarship recipient must complete and return the scholarship Offer prior to the payment of the scholarship.
- 6.2 For the avoidance of doubt, the scholarship recipient acknowledges and agrees that the award of a scholarship is conditional upon the signing and returning to TAFE NSW the scholarship offer and acceptance form.

7.0 Award and payment of the scholarship

- 7.1 Following the completion and return of the scholarship offer and acceptance form, the scholarship funds will be paid as a cheque up to the value of \$2,000.
- 7.2 TAFE NSW and the Legacy Club of Wagga Wagga are under no obligation to pay or make available any part of the scholarship until it has received a signed and completed scholarship offer and acceptance form.

8.0 Conditions of the scholarship

- 8.1 The recipient acknowledges and agrees that the following conditions apply to the award of the Legacy Club of Wagga Wagga Scholarship:
 - 8.1.1 On request by the TAFE NSW, the successful recipient must provide an update on how the scholarship has assisted them in their career journey.
 - 8.1.2 The successful recipient must agree to be available for promotional and marketing photography in line with TAFE NSW's Authority to Publish.
 - 8.1.3 Any decision of the panel regarding a scholarship application is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
 - 8.1.4 The successful recipient is expected to be an ambassador for the TAFE NSW and uphold the values of the organisation and to behave at all times in accordance with the TAFE NSW Student Code of Conduct.

9.0 Variation

- 9.1 TAFE NSW may vary these terms and conditions or any form or process referred to herein at any time and without notice.
