Terms and Conditions

For the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship Awarded by the Hunter TAFE Foundation

1.0 Establishment and Purpose

- 1.1 The Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship was established to offer support and encouragement to promising students who are currently enrolled in the Diploma of Applied Fashion Design and Merchandising (MST50119) at TAFE NSW Newcastle.
- 1.2 The Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship is funded by Darren Hope, and managed and administered by the Hunter TAFE Foundation.
- 1.3 A panel will be established to determine the successful scholarship recipient.
- 1.4 The scholarship delivers \$2,000 to help the scholarship recipient meet costs associated with their studies

2.0 definitions

- 2.1 **“Applicant”** means a student who applies for the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship, by completing and submitting a Moreen Edith application form in accordance with the application process.
- 2.2 **“Application process”** means the process set out in clause 3.0 of these terms and conditions as amended or varied by the Hunter TAFE Foundation, from time to time, in its sole discretion.
- 2.3 **“Eligible applicant”** means an applicant who meets the criteria for eligibility for the award of a Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship, as set out in clause 4.0 of the terms and conditions.
- 2.4 **“Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship”** means a prize to the value of \$2,000, awarded by the Hunter TAFE Foundation in accordance with these terms and conditions.
- 2.5 **“Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship application”** means an application for the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship made by an applicant, in accordance with these terms and conditions.
- 2.6 **“Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship application form”** means the form that must be completed by an applicant, and is available from tafensw.edu.au/scholarships.
- 2.7 **“Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship offer and acceptance form”** means the form that must be completed by the successful applicant and is issued by the Hunter TAFE Foundation.
- 2.8 **“Panel”** means a panel to assess applicants on their application form.
- 2.9 **“Successful applicant”** means an eligible student who is offered the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship by the Hunter TAFE Foundation, in accordance with the process set out in clause 5.0 of these terms and conditions.

2.10 **“Scholarship recipient”** means the successful applicant who accepts the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship, by completing and returning the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship offer and acceptance form in accordance with the process set out in clause 6.0 of these terms and conditions.

2.11 **“Student”** means a currently enrolled student of TAFE NSW.

3.0 Application Process

- 3.1 An applicant must complete a Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship application form and submit it to the Hunter TAFE Foundation by the required closing date, via email, as detailed on the application form.
- 3.2 The applicant must acknowledge and accept the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship terms and conditions by signing and dating their application form prior to submitting the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship application form in the manner set out in clause 3.1.

4.0 Student Eligibility for the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship

- 4.1 The Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship may be awarded to an eligible applicant who has completed and lodged an application form and who, as determined by the panel as eligible (in its sole discretion), satisfies all of the following criteria:
 - 4.1.1 Applicant must be enrolled in the Diploma of Applied Fashion Design and Merchandising (MST50119) at TAFE NSW Newcastle.
 - 4.1.2 Has an excellent attendance record.
 - 4.1.3 Would benefit from the financial assistance provided by the scholarship.
 - 4.1.4 Does not hold another scholarship for the same course or equivalent or more substantial benefit.
- 4.2 Incomplete Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship application forms will not be considered by the panel.
- 4.3 The Hunter TAFE Foundation is under no obligation to attempt to contact any applicant who incorrectly completes and/or submits an application form and will, at his or her discretion, contact an applicant on not more than two (2) occasions in an effort to obtain information which is missing, or has not been completed correctly. Should all required information not be provided, the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship application forms will be withdrawn by the Hunter TAFE Foundation and notice sent to the applicant.

5.0 Offer of the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship

- 5.1 The panel will determine the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship recipients in its sole discretion.
- 5.2 The successful applicant will be notified by telephone and email, and will be sent a Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship offer and acceptance form to complete.
- 5.3 If unsuccessful, an applicant will be notified in writing of the outcome.

6.0 Acceptance of the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship

- 6.1 The scholarship recipient acknowledges and agrees that the awarding of a scholarship is conditional upon the signing and returning to the Hunter TAFE Foundation, the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship offer and acceptance form.

7.0 Award and Payment of the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship

- 7.1 Following the completion and return of the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship offer and acceptance form, scholarship funds to the amount of \$1,000, will be paid via a direct deposit.
- 7.2 The remaining scholarship funds, to the amount of \$1,000, will be paid upon the successful completion of the Diploma of Applied Fashion Design and Merchandising (MST50119).
- 7.3 The Hunter TAFE Foundation is under no obligation to pay or make available, any part of the Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship, until it has received a signed and completed Moreen Edith Fashion Scholarship offer and acceptance form.
