REVIT AND AUTOCAD are the two top software/programming skills in demand for architects and building and engineering technicians in Australia*.

Used across a range of construction, engineering and manufacturing industries, **AUTOCAD** is used for 2D and 3D computer-aided design and drafting. It allows for improved accuracy of plans as well as greater efficiency compared to manual drawing.

REVIT, the more advanced of the two programs, utilises building information modelling (BIM) that allows complex building structures to be virtually designed as well as documented.



CARPENTERS, BUILDER'S LABOURERS AND BUILDING ASSOCIATES



Based on online job postings over the last twelve months in the construction sector, CARPENTER was the most or second most advertised occupation in this industry in all regions apart from Capital region.

BUILDER'S LABOURER was the most or second most advertised position in the Southern Highlands and Shoalhaven, Richmond - Tweed, New England and North West, Murray, Hunter Valley, and Capital regions.

BUILDING ASSOCIATE was the most or second most advertised position in the Central Coast, Newcastle and Lake Macquarie, Sydney, Illawarra, Capital, Riverina, and Mid North Coast regions.

CLEANERS AND PROPERTY MANAGERS



Over the last twelve months, DOMESTIC CLEANER OR COMMERCIAL CLEANER were the most and/or second most advertised occupations in the property sector across all regions apart from the Sydney region.


