employment growth through to 2021*, with over
2,650 additional workers forecast to be employed
in this job in NSW. **OFFICE/ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT** job roles account for a significant
number of job postings in NSW, with over 2,300
online postings for this job role in NSW in the last



CUSTOMER SERVICE REPRESENTATIVE

In the SYDNEY region (the region with the highest proportion of job ads in this industry area), CUSTOMER SERVICE REPRESENTATIVE was the most advertised position in this industry area, with 1,293 jobs advertised over the last three months. This was followed by SALES REPRESENTATIVE with 1,190 postings.



ACCOUNTANT AND RETAIL STORE MANAGER

ACCOUNTANT was the most advertised occupation in this industry area in the NEWCASTLE AND LAKE MACQUARIE region and in the CENTRAL COAST region. RETAIL STORE MANAGER/SUPERVISOR was the most advertised occupation in this industry area in the CENTRAL WEST, FAR WEST AND ORANA, and MID NORTH COAST regions.
