How are the courses delivered?

The courses are delivered by TAFE NSW within your organisation in your country.

- Provide leadership in training and assessment
- Design training programs, learning resources and develop assessment tools
- Engage with industry for learning partnerships
- Mentor trainers and assessors
- Evaluate training and assessment programs
