# **Masterclasses**

TAFE NSW masterclass training actively engages and involves participants in their learning, through the use of roleplay, case studies, group work, and skills practice. Masterclasses can be delivered via connected platforms or in person, and at the completion of each masterclass, participants will receive a TAFE NSW certificate and transcript of study.

Lessons can be delivered with the support of an interpreter and bilingual materials, according to a student's training needs, and academic or industry prerequisites for masterclasses can vary.

# **Early Childhood Education and Care**

This range of specialised, five-day early childhood education and care masterclasses will address the growing demand for reform and standardisation.
