

Connected Learning Centres will provide more choice, better access and convenient training, supported by digital technologies, to students and employers across regional NSW.



The Connected Learning Centre will continue to provide practical learning and will be supported by mobile training units, simulation and virtual reality experiences.


## CONNECTED LEARNING CENTRE: BOURKE
