STUDENT PRIVACY

Information collected by TAFE NSW (the New South Wales TAFE Commission) during a student's enrolment and attendance will be used for the purposes of student record administration, identification, communication, state and national reporting, program monitoring, evaluation and surveys.

Student information will be held securely and disposed of securely when no longer needed. The information may be disclosed when required by law and to government departments and agencies, including for example to Services Australia (Centrelink), the Department of Home Affairs, Transport for NSW, NSW Department of Education, the Australian Skills Quality Authority, the Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency, the Universities Admission Centre, Board of Studies Teaching and Educational Standards NSW and the National Centre for Vocational Education Research. In order to meet the requirements of Registered Training Organisations under the Apprenticeships and Traineeships Act 2001, apprentice and trainee information is provided to employers, Australian Apprenticeship Centres and Training Services NSW (or the relevant State Training Authority).

CONDITIONS

To be eligible to access government subsidised training places in TAFE NSW, students must meet eligibility criteria of being an Australian citizen, an Australian Permanent Resident, a NZ Citizen or a Permanent Humanitarian visa holder and have a NSW residential address or be employed within NSW.

If a student is not a resident of NSW or working

within NSW, fees may vary. Conditions:

- To be eligible to access government subsidised training in TAFE NSW a person must meet the criteria of being an Australian Citizen, an Australian Permanent Resident, a New Zealand Citizen or an identified Humanitarian, refugee or asylum seeker visa holder.
- Australian Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander students living or working within NSW or resident within identified postcodes bordering New South Wales have access to government subsidised training places in TAFENSW.
- Students who will be participating and/or attending training must also have a NSW residential address or be employed within NSW to be eligible to access government subsidised training places in TAFENSW.
- Apprentices who are registered in NSW and training at TAFE NSW will continue to be eligible to access government subsidised training places.
- Trainees who are registered in NSW and training at TAFE NSW will continue to be eligible to access government subsidised training places.
- Separate arrangements apply for apprentices who are registered in other States and Territories and undertake their required training at TAFENSW.
- If a student is not a resident of NSW or working within NSW, a commercial fee applies.
