Welcome to the first Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct community update. These newsletters will keep you connected and up to date on important milestones, online resources and contact details should you have questions.

The future of the Precinct will be realised through brand new, purpose-built education facilities by 2022 and collaboration with industry. The new schools and TAFE NSW facilities will contribute to a renewed Meadowbank area for the community, with improved access to existing and new active transport options.

That means new facilities for 1000 primary students, 1500 secondary students and 120 intensive English students in modern and flexible learning spaces for the relocated Meadowbank Public School and Marsden High School. TAFE NSW Meadowbank will be transformed into a technology-focussed campus featuring a new Multi-Trades and Digital Technology Hub. This will provide a unique industry innovation and collaboration space, transforming training delivery to be more digitally interactive and industry-focussed.

Latest news

The Meadowbank community is one step closer to benefiting from the new education and employment precinct with the contracts awarded for the early works phase of the project.

- The Early Contractor Involvement contract for the Schools has been awarded to Roberts Pizzarotti, which includes completion of the design for the school facilities and remediation of the new site for the two schools.
- Hansen Yuncken has been awarded the Early Contractor Involvement contract for the completion of design for the construction work of the TAFE NSW Multi-Trades and Digital Technology Hub.

- September 2020 ● Main works construction expected to commence
