Becoming a TAFE NSW Teacher.

What do you need to become a teacher at TAFE NSW?

- a nationally recognised qualification in the discipline in which you want to teach
- between three and five years of industry experience (depending on the industry)
- Certificate IV in Training and Assessment [TAE40116] or a relevant education qualification

Have the skills and industry qualification but don't have a Certificate IV in Training and Assessment?

You can gain your Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (TAE40116) via the TAFE NSW Teacher Scholarship program.

What is the Teacher Scholarship Program?

The Teacher Scholarship Program is a fully funded program, that will cover the cost of your TAE course.

How is the Certificate IV in Training and Assessment [TAE40116] delivered?

Following an application process, successful Teacher Scholarship participants will have the option to complete their studies via face-to-face, connected classroom (via MS Teams) or on-line.

How long do Teacher Scholarship participants have to complete their studies?

Up to 18 months.

If you are looking at completing your studies on-line within 12 months, you would need to commit to approximately 12 hours per week.

Teacher Scholarship Program Benefits?

- flexibility to combine teaching, work, and lifestyle
- join a team of passionate teachers inspiring the next generation of students
- change a student's life and help them get skilled and ready for the industry
- option to upgrade to the Diploma of Adult Education - a potential pathway to becoming a Head Teacher
- option to participate in the industry release program to build on emerging skills

How are TAE Scholarship participants supported?

Each TAE Scholarship participant will have a mentor allocated to them.

Your mentor will maintain regular contact throughout your course, providing advice to help resolve issues, as well as supporting your move to teaching.

The Certificate IV in Training and Assessment delivery team will also provide support and advice with your learning and assessment tasks.
