Government subsidised training, including Smart and Skilled

CONDITIONS

To be eligible to access government subsidised training places in TAFE NSW, learners must meet eligibility criteria of being an Australian citizen, an Australian Permanent Resident, a NZ Citizen or a Permanent Humanitarian visa holder and have a NSW residential address or be employed within NSW.

If a learner is not a resident of NSW or working within NSW, fees may vary.

Conditions:

- To be eligible to access government subsidised training in TAFE NSW a person must meet the criteria of being an Australian Citizen, an Australian Permanent Resident, a New Zealand Citizen or a Permanent Humanitarian visa holder.
- Australian Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander learners living or working within NSW or resident within identified postcodes bordering New South Wales have access to government subsidised training places in TAFE NSW.
- Learners who will be participating and/or attending training must also have a NSW residential address or be employed within NSW to be eligible to access government subsidised training places in TAFE NSW.
- · Apprentices who are registered in NSW and training at TAFE NSW will continue to be eligible to access government subsidised training places.
- · Trainees who are registered in NSW and training at TAFE NSW will continue to be eligible to access government subsidised training places.
- Separate arrangements apply for apprentices who are registered in other States and Territories and undertake their required training at TAFE NSW.
- · If a student is not a resident of NSW or working within NSW, fees will vary and these fees will be determined by each Institute.

LEARNER PRIVACY

Information collected by the New South Wales TAFE Commission during a learner's enrolment and attendance will be used for the purposes of general record administration, identification, communication, state and national reporting, program monitoring, evaluation and surveys.

Learner information will be held securely and disposed of securely when no longer needed.

The information may be disclosed to the Department of Human Services (Centrelink), the Department of Veterans` Affairs, the Department of Education and Training, the Department of Industry and Science, the Department of Immigration and Border Protection, Transport for NSW, NSW Department of Industry, Skills & Regional Development, the Australian Skills Quality Authority, the Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency, the Universities Admission Centre, Office of the Board of Studies and the National Centre for Vocational Education Research. In order to meet the requirements of Registered Training Organisations under the Apprenticeships and Traineeships Act 2001, apprentice and trainee information is provided to employers, Australian Apprenticeship Centres and NSW Skills and Industry Policy Division (or the relevant State Training Authority).

While the provision of the information requested on this form is not required by law, it is a requirement of TAFE NSW and your enrolment will not be accepted if it is not provided.
