This course is designed to help learners further their talents in applying quality auditing skills and

knowledge and use a range of specialised, technical or managerial competencies to plan, carry out and evaluate their own work or the work of a team. It is an ideal course for learners who would like to have their existing skills recognised or upgraded or who would like to progress in the workplace as quality assurance managers, quality facilitators, quality and improvement consultants or service quality system support analysts.

Once learners have successfully completed this course they will receive a nationally recognised qualification in BSB51615 - Diploma in Quality Auditing.

Units of competence in this qualification will give them the skills for:

- Identifying the framework of a quality management system aligned to International Standards
- Initiating and leading a quality management system audit
- Reporting the findings on a quality management system audit within a report

Learners may enrol into this course anytime and may complete this course through external study over 36 weeks. Once payment is received or VET Student Loan arranged, the facilitator will instruct learners on accessing our online sites and give them the tools to help complete this course successfully.

SMART AND SKILLED FEES
