Course Description

This course is for workers who may be required to provide a first aid response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings. You will learn how to respond in an emergency situation, apply appropriate first aid procedures, communicate details of the incident and evaluate your own performance. When you finish this course you can undertake further First Aid training in other first aid related occupational courses. Advanced standing may be granted in courses where providing first aid in a workplace is a part of the course. Refresher training in CPR should be undertaken annually and full first aid qualifications should be renewed every three (3) years.

You are required to: * Complete the Online Training Program prior to attending the assessment. * Book an assessment time online and attend a TAFE college nearby for the practical assessment (once you have

finished working through all of the information in the online course). * Print and bring your completed online workbook and manual (required for the practical assessment). * Complete all practical skills assessments successfully. This includes demonstration and essential knowledge in CPR using adult and infant manikin, first aid response in a scenario situation and management of Anaphylaxis and Asthma using standard first aid equipment.
