- Have a high level of physical fitness and manual dexterity
- It is recommended that you have completed year 12 or the equivalent

To be prepared for this course, it is recommended that you have:

- Good hand-eye coordination
- First Aid
- Spatial awareness
- Manual dexterity

LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

There are no occupational licensing, legislative or certification requirements that apply to this qualification.

However, employers should have a workplace safety management plan that describes reaccreditation requirements (normally three years) wherever chainsaws are used.
