## **WORK PLACEMENT**

At TAFE NSW we provide training that includes hands-on, practical experience. Work placement ensures you have the job ready skills to achieve competency in this course.

We strongly recommend 72 hours of work placement with a suitable industry employer to get the most out of your study, expand your network and get real world experience; however, industry work placement it is not compulsory.

Should you choose to complete the nominated 72 hours in industry, you will need to arrange work placement with a suitable employer. Your teachers will arrange an appointment with you to provide more information.

If you are unable to secure work placement with an industry partner, you will be required to complete 72 hours of clinic work in a simulated workplace environment. This will occur at your campus location during normal class times on a day nominated by your teaching section.

Whether you are enrolled full-time or part-time, it is recommended that you start your work placement in week one (1) from the start date of your enrolment.

To successfully complete this course, you will need:

While work placement is strongly encouraged it is not compulsory. Achieving competency with the addition of 72hrs work placement will ensure competency is more easily achieved. Learners who are unable to find their own suitable work placement, will be required to complete 72hrs of clinic work in a simulated workplace environment at TAFE during normal class times on a day nominated by the teaching section.

## Information Sessions and more about the course

### STUDY COMMITMENT

This is a Full Time Blended course. You will need to attend approximately 21 hours of class, over 3 days a week, for 18 weeks. As well as the in-class component, you will need to complete approximately 7 hours of other study per week.

You may also be required to complete approximately 8 hours of additional study each week outside of class hours, including (Private study, assignment preparation, work experience and research).

### IS THIS COURSE RIGHT FOR YOU?

This course offering is designed for people who:

- The purpose of this qualification is to provide opportunities to individuals that are interested in developing their skills and knowledge, in preparation for their employment into a beauty service or related industry. This qualification complements the forecast growth in the personal care service industry to employ new workers that are job ready in a range of beauty services that include: nails, waxing, lash, brow, and basic make-up services.
