Course Description

This qualification reflects the roles of training developers and instructional designers who are responsible for analysing training needs and designing training solutions and products to meet workplace capability requirements, and evaluating the effectiveness of training programs. They may have a role in providing guidance and advice to trainers and assessors, promoting innovative practices, e.g. e-learning, and in researching and incorporating best practice in training and assessment into training programs and products.

The volume of learning of a Diploma of Training Design and Development is typically one to two years.

You will be required to complete approximately 5 hours of self-directed learning per week.

ATTENDANCE INFORMATION

Students will need to spend a minimum 10 hours per week completing learning activities and up to 15 hours completing assessment tasks as per the course timetable. As this is an online delivery model course work will be made available to you on Thursdays, LIVE webinars will be held each Thursday from 7.30pm, LIVE group collaboration sessions will be held on Tuesdays from 6.30pm. The teacher will also facilitate scheduled workshops on selected Thursday evenings commencing at 6pm at on Campus. Campus location and specific details will be provided on commencement of the course. You will be provided with a delivery schedule so that you can see when the workshops are scheduled well in advance.
