TRAINING PACKAGE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

To be eligible for this course, you must:

- Identify as an Aboriginal person and be accepted and acknowledged as such within your community
- Participate in a phone interview with a TAFE NSW teacher to make sure this course is right for you

Evidence required

- A confirmation of Aboriginality letter may be requested

In NSW, Confirmation of Aboriginality letters can be issued by any NSW Aboriginal organisation or Local Aboriginal Land Council. Refer to the Department of Aboriginal Affairs for further details.

WORK EXPERIENCE

There is no mandatory work placement for this qualification. However, this is a practical qualification. We strongly recommend you undertake work experience with a suitable industry employer or community organisation.

Work experience provides you with exposure to situations and circumstances that cannot be replicated in a learning or simulated environment and strengthens your training at TAFE NSW.
