COURSE SUCCESS REQUIREMENTS

During your study, you will need to meet specific requirements that are necessary for you to complete your course work and be successful.

You will need to meet the following success requirements to be able to undertake work placement within industry. Your teacher will let you know when you need to provide evidence of:

- TL100 Refrigeration and air conditioning trainee licence

Once you have enrolled in this course, you will need to obtain a TL100 Refrigeration and air conditioning trainee licence from the Australian Refrigeration Council.

To obtain the trainee licence, you will need:

- Proof of course enrolment. TAFE NSW student services can provide you with:
- TAFE NSW confirmation of enrolment document
- TAFE NSW Tax invoice (for fee paying students)
- A [signed declaration by your work supervisor]
