WORK PLACEMENT

TVET students

If you are a TVET student you must complete mandatory work placement.

The NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA) outlines:

- 35 hours per year of work placement if you undertake the course over two years
- 70 hours per year of work placement if you undertake the course over one year

Depending on your campus location, there may be other variations to work placement requirements.

Non-TVET students

There is no mandatory work placement requirement to achieve the qualification for non-TVET students. However, we do recommend that you secure work experience to support your learning.
