ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

TAFE NSW offers the Certificate III in Automotive Electrical Technology as an apprenticeship. There may also be options available for you to study as a non-apprentice.

Apprenticeship

To be eligible for this course, you must:

- Be employed as an apprentice in the automotive industry evidenced by a letter of support from your employer
- Submit your training plan proposal (TPP) with your application

Non-apprenticeship

There may be options available for you to study as a non-apprentice. Enquire today and our Apprenticeship and Traineeship team will support you to understand any eligibility or entry requirements for our non-apprenticeship qualifications.

Note: You can also begin your auto electrical career by undertaking the Certificate II in Automotive Electrical Technology. The Certificate II is a recognised pre-apprenticeship that provides a pathway into the sector and 120 hours of work placement experience.

COURSE SUCCESS REQUIREMENTS

During your study, you will need to meet specific requirements that are necessary for you to complete your course work and be successful.

As part of your training, Government licensing requires that all apprentice technicians hold a refrigeration and air conditioning (TL000) trainee licence. You will obtain the credits needed for this licence by successfully completing the following units in the second year of this course:

- AURETU002 Recover vehicle refrigerants
- AURETU003 Service air conditioning and HVAC systems
- AURETU004 Diagnose and repair air conditioning and HVAC systems
