- De-nib, buff and polish vehicle painted surfaces
- Apply clear over base two-pack refinishing materials and clear over base multi-layer and pearl refinishing materials to vehicle body components
- Apply water-based refinishing materials to vehicle bodies and substrates
- Follow environmental and sustainability best practice and safe working practices in an automotive workplace
