TAFE NSW offers the Certificate III in Formwork/Falsework as an apprenticeship. There may also be options available for you to study as a non-apprentice.

To be eligible for this course, you need to demonstrate the following:

- That you hold a valid general construction induction card (commonly known as a white card)

Apprenticeship

In addition to meeting the above requirement, apprentices must:

- Be employed as an apprentice in the formwork or falsework industry as evidenced by a letter of support from your employer
- Submit your Training Plan Proposal (TPP) with your application

Non-apprenticeship

Enquire today and one of our Apprenticeship and Traineeship team will help you understand any eligibility or entry requirements.

WORK PLACEMENT

There is no work placement requirement for this qualification. As an apprentice, you will gain your experience on-the-job with your employer.

If you are enrolling as a non-apprentice, you need to be in relevant employment or have access to appropriate simulated workplace environments in order to meet the course completion requirements.

LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

Upon completing the Certificate III in Formwork/Falsework, you'll be eligible to apply for a licence in General Concreting.
