TRAINING PACKAGE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

To be eligible for this course, you must:

- Hold a valid general construction induction card (commonly known as a white card)

TAFE NSW offers the Certificate III in Fire Protection as an apprenticeship. There may also be options available for you to study as a non-apprentice.

Apprenticeship

To be eligible for this course, you must:

- Be employed as an apprentice in the fire protection industry evidenced by a letter of support from your employer
- Submit your training plan proposal (TPP) with your application

Non-apprenticeship

To be eligible for a subsidised place in this course as a non-apprentice, you must:

- Be over 21 years of age
- Provide evidence, such as a resume or letter of support from your employer, of significant and current industry experience.

If there are gaps in your industry experience, you will need to complete simulated work activities to ensure you are able to meet work evidence requirements.

WORK PLACEMENT

There is no work placement requirement for apprentices taking this qualification, as you will gain your experience on-the-job with your employer.

Non-apprentices will need to be in either relevant employment or have access to appropriate simulated workplace environments to complete the learning and assessment requirements.
