ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

TAFE NSW offers the Certificate IV in Plumbing and Services (Operations Stream) as an apprenticeship. There may also be options available for you to study as a non-apprentice.

To be eligible for this course, you need to demonstrate the following:

- Successful completion of a relevant Certificate III Plumbing trade qualification or equivalent, as evidenced by your academic transcript

Apprenticeship

In addition to meeting the above requirement, apprentices must:

- Be employed as an apprentice in the plumbing industry as evidenced by a letter of support from your employer
- Submit your Training Plan Proposal (TPP) with your application

Non-apprenticeship

There may be options for you to study as a non-apprentice. Enquire today and one of our Apprenticeship and Traineeship team will help you understand any eligibility or entry requirements

LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

When you successfully complete the Certificate IV in Plumbing (Operations Stream), you can apply for licensing with NSW Fair Trading. Fair Trading NSW is the licensing and regulatory authority for trades and contractor authorities in NSW, and further information can be found on their website.
