- Completed the Diploma of Screen and Media
- Relevant experience in screen and media by submitting a portfolio

Your portfolio needs to include a short show reel with original work that demonstrates you can:

- Apply visually interesting graphics and effects to a story
- Produce projects using screen and media techniques
- Produce projects that are either two-dimensional or three-dimensional focused
- Apply and manipulate imagery, sound and light to produce an engaging visual story

Your skills and knowledge may have been acquired through screen and media work experience or through formal study.

- Have a passion for story telling

- **RADIO and JOURNALISM** stretches your existing skills to a professional level, with innovative ways of presenting, interviewing, running radio equipment, producing shows writing, shooting, editing for modern journalism consumed online, on phones, on TV, on Radio and in print
- **ANIMATION** to prepare you for a professional career in Film, TV, Games and more including study towards the TAFE NSW Bachelor of 3D Art and Animation

- GAME DEVELOPMENT builds on the Diploma of Digital and Interactive Games and enables you to create your own unique professional level game and pitch it to industry
