To be eligible for this course, you need to demonstrate the following:

- That you have achieved a Year 12 high school certificate or an equivalent as evidenced by a copy of your certificate, or
- That you have achieved a Certificate IV in Information Technology as evidenced by a copy of your certificate or transcript, or
- That you have recent or current work experience in the Information Technology networking field as evidenced by a letter of support from your employer or your resume, or
- Before your first day of class you must complete a Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) skills test and achieve a score of 4 across the five bands of literacy and 4 across one band of numeracy. This helps us to determine that your skills match the demands of the course, to direct you to an alternative study option or to provide you with the appropriate [support for your success](#). Your teacher will let you know when this must be completed.

Traineeship

TAFE NSW also offers the Diploma in Information Technology as a traineeship. In addition to meeting the above requirement/s, trainees must:

- Be employed in the information technology industry as this course is delivered in the workplace
- Have a signed traineeship contract
