LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

The maritime industry is regulated by the Australian Marine Safety Authority (AMSA). AMSA sets specific requirements for each maritime qualification to ensure you are ready to join the industry.

Once you graduate from your TAFE NSW course, you will be assessed against the relevant requirements through an AMSA examination process. Graduating from this course only meets part of the AMSA exam criteria. You will need to meet other requirements through your professional sea service and medical status.

AMSA licensing requirements include:

- Minimum age requirements when applying for your AMSA certificate
- Medical and eyesight requirements
- Minimum professional sea time hours

The nationally accredited Certificate IV in Maritime Operations (Master up to 35 metres Near Coastal) at TAFE NSW gives you the skills and training needed to apply for an AMSA certificate of capacity and work as a master on domestic vessels up to 35 m long, or chief mate on vessels up to 80m.

LEARN NEW SKILLS

Through a mix of theory and practical coursework, learn to:

- Monitor and manage vessel operations
- Manage a small crew
- Operate deck machinery and steering gear on a vessel up to 80 m
- Manage the loading, discharging and stowing of cargo
- Use wheelhouse equipment for safe navigation
- Forecast weather and oceanographic conditions
- Observe regulations to ensure the safe operation of a vessel
