Apprenticeship

To be eligible for this course, you must:

- Be employed as an apprentice in the jewellery industry evidenced by a letter of support from your employer
- Submit your training plan proposal (TPP) with your application

Non-apprenticeship

- You will need to secure work placement (details below) to meet the on-the-job component of your training

It is important to know that there is no government subsidy available for this study option. Talk to our team about your payment options.

WORK PLACEMENT

There is no work placement requirement for apprentices undertaking this qualification, as you will gain your experience on-the-job with your employer.

Non-apprentices will need to be in either relevant employment or have access to appropriate simulated workplace environments to complete the learning and assessment requirements.

You are responsible for arranging your own work placement. Our team can offer support and guidance to assist you.
