Apprenticeship

To be eligible for this course, you must:

- Be employed as an apprentice in the marine construction industry as evidenced by a letter of support from your employer
- Submit your Training Plan Proposal (TPP) with your application

Non-apprenticeship

There are no entry requirements for non-apprentices studying this qualification. It is important to know that there is no government subsidy available for this study option. Talk to our team about your payment options.

WORK PLACEMENT

There is no work placement requirement for this qualification. As an apprentice, you will gain your experience on-the-job with your employer.

If you are enrolling as a non-apprentice, you need to be in relevant employment or have access to appropriate simulated workplace environments in order to meet the course completion requirements.
