LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

This course is primarily aimed at those who wish to later apply for a Customs Broker Licence.

Customs broker licences are issued by the Comptroller-General of Customs upon the recommendation by the National Customs Brokers Licensing Advisory Committee (NCBLAC).
